Footnotes

MAMA JANKA content to lag back early, roused nearing the turn, moved up two then three wide around the turn, came out further in upper stretch, rallied strongly and inhaled inside rivals to be along in time under hand urging. CIACCI'S ANGEL was fractious in the gate, tracked pacesetter from the outside, under strong asking around the turn, loomed outside leader entering the lane, grabbed brief lead passing sixteenth marker but was no match for winner late. H. J.'S KITTYY saved ground chasing the pace into the stretch, swung out then closed strongly through the lane to prove best of others. TO THE TOP quickly sped to the front, set uncontested pace while slightly off the fence, continued on two wide path, was overtaken nearing sixteenth marker and weakened. SIGN IN chased from the inside, hugged the rail around the turn and into the stretch and lacked effective late punch. ASHABU showed good early foot, prominently placed from between horses, dropped back around the bend on two then three wide path and also weakened. ESCUINAPA was bit slow to begin and lagged back early, trailed from off the rail, raced three wide leaving the turn and was never a factor.
