Footnotes

SKYATTIC dueled from between rivals then inside foe, gained slim advantage in upper stretch and determinedly held under right hand urging. UNUSUAL SOUL contested the early pace three deep then outside winner on the turn, battled outside SKYATTIC to the wire but could not get past that rival. DANCER MAN broke through the gate prior to the start, settled off the pace, came out some then moved up three then four wide into the lane, inched closed in the drive, loomed late and finished well outside top pair. MAJOR GENERAL settled well off fence then outside foe, chased three then four wide into the stretch and produced mild outside rally. DINNER AT JAKE'S unhurried early, angled over some, chased two wide into the lane, roused then rallied strongly, forced to steady off heels nearing the wire and lacked any room late. SWISS ALPINE forced then stalked pace from the inside, hugged the rail into the lane and lacked needed late punch. ECHO WEST angled over while showing early speed, dueled inside into the bend, dropped back into the lane then weakened. SEVEN BELOW was off step slow, chased off the rail, came out further and was forced five wide leaving the turn and faded from the far outside.
