RICKY EL CORREDOR unhurried leaving the gate, chased from off the rail then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the lane, roused and rallied strongly from outside and was along in time. MISSILE MISSILE was hustled to the front, set pressured pace while slightly off the fence, battled outside foe in the lane, clung to narrow advantage in deep stretch but could not stave off the winner. SILVER HELMET rushed up along the rail, pressured the pacesetter then hooked up in stretch duel, battled gamely to the wire but was outfinished. MEDIA MAKER attended the early pace from the outside, continued four wide into and around the turn while forcing the issue, was inside winner in upper stretch, could not match that rival and just missed the show. WEGOTLUCKY was off bit slow and inward, stalked from along the rail, continued inside into the lane, came out some and finished well from between horses. PISTOU forced the early pace, continued outside foe to the turn, dropped back bit from between horses then weakened late.
