R. C. STORM was quickest leaving the gate and sped well clear, set uncontested pace from the inside into the stretch and was under steady urging late to safely hold. TABLE FOR ONE tracked pacesetter while outside rival into turn, continued on same path around the turn and into the stretch and went willingly to the wire. SURROUND chased early from along the rail, shifted out on the turn, came two wide into the stretch, angled out further and finished strongly. WARRENSMYSTERYDICE settled well off the rail, later angled over some but failed to threaten. SOLDIER BETTY was bit slow to begin, saved ground chasing the pace and never reached contention. OUR LITTLE KITTY tracked pacesetter from the inside, steadied sharply passing quarter marker, dropped back and never recovered. The stewards conducted an inquiry involving the incident at the quarter marker but did not change the official order of finish.
