**Footnotes**

RITZVILLE vied for the lead along the inside into the turn, cleared foes around the bend, then held safely under urging to the wire. ROAD TO THE THRONE vied for command while three deep off the fence, lost touch with the leader and chased around the bend, then held the place in the stretch. GOLDEN AUGUSTO unhurried in the early stages, traveled along the inside around the bend, came out into the lane, then surged late. CRISTALANO vied for the lead from between rivals into the turn, failed to match strides and chased on the turn, then weakened in the stretch. BLUE MOON SLEW failed to show early foot, went two to three wide on the bend and failed to threaten. RAMBO NATION showed no early speed, raced along the rail and was never a factor.
