PRETTY DARN QUICK dueled for command from the inside, kicked clear of rival leaving the bend, held a comfortable lead at the top of the stretch, weakened late but just lasted. HEY YUP broke out, unhurried in the early stages, raced off the rail to the lane, finished with a late rush but was denied. BACKSTREET BOSS raced along the inside and off the pace, steadied into the turn, raced two wide on the bend, angled out entering the stretch and showed a late effort. DECARCHY'S TRIESTE broke out, raced three wide around the turn and never produced a rally. KETTLE MAN settled in the early going, raced two wide into the turn, angled in and saved ground into the stretch but failed to rally. AUGSBURG dueled for command from the outside with PRETTY DARN QUICK into the turn, could not keep up with winner around the turn and gave way.
