QEIGHT DIESEL was hustled to the front then set pressured pace from outside rival, edged away under urging into the stretch, remained bit off the rail and safely held under right hand pressure. POPPY PEAK stalked while outside rival to the turn, continued outside same foe while three then caught four wide into the lane and whittled gap on winner late from the outside. LAST CHANCE BOBBY exchanged bumps with outside rival in initial strides, tucked in behind dueling leaders, stalked pace, angled out on the turn, came three wide into the lane and was outfinished for second. RESPECT LIFE broke alertly and pressured the pacesetter from the inside, continued prominently into the stretch but weakened in the drive. LISKEY unhurried early from the inside, angled out on the turn, departed the bend three wide and lacked needed response. EL CUARENTA broke bit slow and inward then exchanged bumps with inside rival, lagged back from off the rail, chased three then four wide to the lane and never menaced. RAISIN BRAN settled off the leaders, shifted over, chased while outside rival, later gained the rail and weakened.
