MO'S LIL' INDIAN flashed good early foot inside, set pressured pace to the turn, drifted out bit entering the lane, turned back inside rival and padded margin late. OUR JUKE BOX HERO reserved from the outside, chased four wide into the turn, angled over, came two wide into the lane, angled back out some in the drive and nailed rival for second. WARREN'S SANJAYA showed good early foot, taken to inside, stalked then loomed in upper stretch but failed to sustain effort and lost the place. RAZZ ATTACK reserved from the inside, lacked room along the rail on the turn, shifted out exiting the turn, came out further in the lane and went willingly to the wire. BOBBY THE FAT BOY tracked pace from along the rail, inside runner-up around the turn, remained along the fence and finished evenly. RICKY EL CORREDOR was slow into stride, lagged back from well off the rail, chased three wide then outside foe and failed to threaten. MORE THAN CLASS dueled then pressured the pacesetter into and around the turn, came three wide into the stretch and retreated in the lane.
