SOMETHING SONIC quickly grabbed command, padded lead around the turn, continued on two wide path into the lane and proved best under steady hand pressure while drifting out some late. THUNDER ONE stalked from between horses then two wide, came out bit leaving the turn and went willingly to the wire. SCOTTY'S LADD prominently placed early from the outside, caught three deep into the bend, raced four wide on the turn then five wide into the stretch and gamely gained third. CHIEF'S LAKE between horses early then three abreast on the backstretch, between foes again on the turn, forced four wide into the lane and was outfinished for the show. PREACH THE GOSPEL was off slow then lagged back early from the inside, in bit tight entering the turn, came off the fence and was no threat. WHY KNOT US settled off the rail, chased on three wide path into and around the turn and lacked needed rally. SPEEDY SWISS was close up early, dropped back from the inside on the turn, came off the fence and weakened. SEAFIRE lagged back early from well off the rail and was outrun throughout.
