HEAVENLY BEING dueled outside rival early, gained slim advantage into the lead, stretched that lead into the stretch then powered away under steady handling. JENNIFER DOLL was slow to begin, chased from the inside, shifted out approaching the stretch, was four wide into the lane, came back in some and cleared from others. WARRENSMYSTERYDICE dropped well back early, trailed from the inside, continued along the rail and was along for third. CUVEE BLUSH chased from between horses, remained two wide into the turn, came out further and failed to threaten. STREET RAT CRAZY was very hard to load, settled, outside, stalked three deep into the bend, caught four wide leaving the turn and weakened. R. C. STORM dueled from the inside then forced the pace, dropped back on the turn and gave way in the lane.
