Footnotes

IRON SLEW broke inward, stalked the pacesetter into the turn, rushed up and quickly grabbed command outside that rival, raced three wide into the lane and stubbornly held under urging. HOUSE OF CRYSTAL saved ground chasing the pace, moved up while bit off the rail, split rivals leaving the turn then loomed inside winner in the drive but was turned back. HURRICANE KATE close up early, stalked outside foe around the turn then three wide exiting the turn and finished willingly from the outside. CAPER SLEW angled in early, chased on two wide path, later shifted back out entering the lane but was no serious factor. HEY DONTBENCHME quickly sped to the front and secured the inside, set the pace into the turn, had little resistance for the winner and faded from along the rail. FRIENDLY MYSTERY chased the pace from the inside, saved ground into the stretch, came out bit late but failed to threaten. SENORITA SEASON lagged back early, raced on three wide path into the stretch and was outrun throughout.
