Footnotes

WILBUR CODWEN close up early from the inside, stalked two wide then along the rail, came back out in upper stretch, rallied under right hand urging and nailed leader nearing wire. KENTER CANYON sped to the front, padded cushion around the turn, weakened from the inside in the drive and could not stave off the winner. SEVEN BELOW was closest pursuer from bit off the fence, came out bit leaving the turn, then lugged out in the drive and held third. SWISS ALPINE was washy in the post parade, settled inside, dropped back bit on the turn, came off the rail and went willingly to the wire. GOOCHIO broke in and bumped rival, stalked from the outside, continued four then three wide to the stretch and was outfinished for better placing. SURPRISEFOR TOULLA broke out and bumped foe, unhurried early, shifted in and never menaced. DINNER AT JAKE'S was bumped then squeezed back at the start, lagged back early, also angled over some and was no threat. OLY'S OFFSPRING was bumped on both sides leaving the gate, stalked early from the outside, dropped back and weakened. BLEND AND COAST settled off the leaders and bit off the rail, also lost contact around the turn and faded.
