Footnotes

TIZ A BRITE MISS broke out and bumped rival, quickly recovered and contested the pace from the inside, gained lead on the turn, drifted out slightly exiting the turn and safely held under urging. SASSY BRITCHES was bumped and forced out leaving the gate, showed good early foot outside winner then forced the pace, raced three wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside same rival. LIMERICK LANE settled off the pace while angling over, steadied sharply off heels nearing quarter marker, found the fence on the turn then rallied strongly along the fence to gain third. PRINCESS ANNABELLA was also bumped and forced out at the start, gained stalking position while bit off the rail, continued on same path and was overtaken for the show. MOLOKINI stalked from off the rail, continued three then two wide into the lane, was between horses in upper stretch and lacked needed rally. LORENBRAY came out in opening strides and slammed into outside rival, tracked pace on three wide path and later weakened. DANCE LITTLE ANGEL bumped heard with inside rival in initial strides, reserved from well off the fence, remained four wide and was no factor. LA HIJO MAESTRIA was slammed from both sides at the start and knocked sideways on the second bump, dropped far back and was outrun throughout.
