**Footnotes**

POPPY PEAK rushed up from along the rail to briefly duel then set the pace, shook loose around the turn and continued to increase winning margin while kept to task. PLAYFUL STUDENT stalked early from the outside, lugged out early on the turn, remained well off the fence into and through the stretch and was along late for second. RESPECT LIFE angled over leaving backstretch chute and pressured the pacesetter on the backstretch, lost contact into and around the bend, came in bit and held third. BESSEMER VICTORY settled outside rival then between horses, remained on same path around the turn and failed to seriously threaten. MINISTER EXPRESS was bumped at the start then forced inward early, stalked from the inside, later secured the rail and lost placing in the drive. EL CUARENTA settled outside then chased three abreast, raced three wide on the turn and lacked needed stretch response. RACER MOBILE was fractious in the gate then bumped at the start, reserved from the inside, saved ground into the lane, came out bit and was outrun. TOSHIE BOY settled outside foe then chased from between horses, came in bit on the turn, steadied off heels approaching the stretch, came in and never recovered. RED FLYER unhurried while well off fence, raced four wide into the bend, came in bit, swung back out some and was outrun throughout.
