TRUCO LATINO was sent up inside to engage rivals then set pressured pace from the inside, held slim advantage on two wide path into the lane, then stubbornly resisted through grueling drive and prevailed on bob at the wire. SPARTAN JET forced the early issue from between horses and three abreast, continued on same path into the lane, loomed outside pacesetter then inched closer approaching the wire but was denied. JOHAN prompted the early pace from the outside, was caught four wide into and around the turn, lost contact in upper stretch but bested others. SUMMER ARROW forced the pace from between rivals and outside eventual winner, was trying to get out around the turn, dropped back approaching the top of the stretch and never recovered. BIG G'S DANCE content to lag back from the inside, hugged the rail into the stretch and lacked needed late response.
