**Footnotes**

SINGLE SHOT forced the early issue from the inside, came out slightly then moved up on two wide path into the lane, challenged inside pacesetter, briefly battled, gained lead and inched away late under urging. AMERICAN EXCESS quickly stepped to the front, set pace while slightly off the fence, lugged out around the turn but still retained the lead, came four wide into the lane, resisted outside winner, gave ground grudgingly late but lasted for second. MY CHARMING CHANCE close up early from the inside, dropped back slightly and came off the rail, moved up three wide, closed in the drive from between foes, was in bit tight in final yards and just missed the place. ROYAL ALEXANDER chased from off the rail and outside rival around the turn, drifted out some in upper stretch and lacked needed late punch. OUR LITTLE KITTY reserved from along the rail, saved ground throughout but never menaced.
