Footnotes

GAME OF LUCK set pressured pace early from the outside, shook free into and around the turn, angled to the rail and comfortably held under steady handling. TRUE TO SUMMING broke inward and bumped rival, forced the early issue from between horses and inside winner, lost contact on the turn, came three wide into the lane and re-rallied for second. FOR CONTRAST prominent early from the inside, continued along the rail then two wide leaving the turn and was outfinished for second. BRIDGE TOO FAR was bumped and forced inward leaving the gate, chased from the inside, saved ground throughout and finished willingly. OUT OF SEATTLE close up early from between foes then outside, stalked on three wide path, dropped back around the turn and lacked any late response. NORTHERN CAPER settled off the leaders and off the rail, came in some around the bend and failed to threaten. RAZZ ATTACK was void of any early foot, chased while bit off the fence and never menaced. LITE NELLY was bumped and forced inward at the start, chased from off the rail throughout and faded. The rider of BRIDGE TOO FAR claimed foul against TRUE TO SUMMING for interference at the start but the stewards disallowed the foul, claiming the incident did not warrant a change.
