STAR SPOOL quickly sped to the front, responded when challenged on the turn, remained bit off the rail into the stretch and determinedly held. COLOR OF DECEPTION broke out bit, moved up and forced pace outside winner, continued on same path but was turned back. NATIONWIDE FAMILY tracked the leaders from the inside, advanced and loomed in the drive and finished willingly inside the winner. POWER TOOL settled inside, hugged the rail throughout but lacked needed late punch. STANFORD GOLD chased outside foe then three wide into the stretch and finished evenly. DIYSEM was squeezed back at the start, lagged back inside, saved ground throughout but was no factor. SOCIETIES BEST broke inward, reserved off the pace, chased on two wide path and was also no late factor. MOONLIGHT KNIGHT reserved from well off the rail, chased three then four wide to the stretch and was outrun throughout.
