Footnotes

UNIQUE EFFORT prompted the early issue from the outside, engaged pacesetter four wide approaching the stretch, reached the front leaving the turn, edged away and held sway under urging. NATIONWIDE FAMILY dueled from the inside early, held slight advantage into the bend, drifted out three wide on the turn, relinquished the lead entering the stretch, came in some in the drive and went gamely to the wire. KALOOKAN HEAT dueled then forced the pace from between horses, lost contact on the turn, angled in some in the stretch and finished much best of the rest. LAS VEGAS LUCKY reserved from the inside, chased either two or three wide into the stretch and improved placing. AQUICKSTING unhurried from well off the fence, chased outside foe then four wide and lacked needed response. WARREN'S YODLER showed good early foot, dropped back from between foes, came in bit and weakened. SKYATTIC lagged back early, chased three wide and off the rail while outrun throughout.
