**Footnotes**

HIGHLY UNUSUAL sped clear soon after the start, padded lead around the turn, then drew off to prove best. CHIEF'S LAKE broke in and bumped foe at the start, angled out around the turn, lugged in during the stretch run and surged late to gain the place. WARREN'S YODLER chased the pace while racing in the two path, then weakened late but held the show. TOM'S LIGHTNING tracked in the early going, took the turn three wide, then failed to rally when asked. TURNAGAIN TAYLOR chased in the early stages from along the inside, then weakened late. DEGREKO raced near the middle of the pack, took the turn four wide, then checked near the sixteenths pole in the stretch. FOR CONTRAST settled off the pace, angled in and found the rail, lacked room entering the stretch, then finished evenly down the lane. KENNETH'S WARRIOR raced near the back of the pack, traveled off the rail into the stretch, and proved no menace. SOMETHING SONIC bumped start, unhurried down the backstretch, raced along the inside around the turn, came out nearing the eighth pole, then checked nearing the sixteenth pole during the stretch run. THUNDER ONE tracked the pace in the early going, floated out by rival around the turn, then faded out of contention.
