JOSHUAS BRIDE angled over and pressured the inside pacesetter into the turn, moved up around the bend, was fanned four wide into the stretch, reached even terms, briefly battled then inched away under urging. WINE N MAXINE quickly sped to the front, dictated pace from the inside, drifted out bit entering the lane, came in slightly and resisted to the sixteenth marker before giving ground. CEE CALLY DANCE angled over the tracked the leading pair into the bend, hugged the rail into the stretch and clearly bested others. ROYAL CHAVELA unhurried while well off the fence, came in bit chasing the pace, raced on two wide path most of the remaining way and never menaced. OUR PLATA settled inside, saved ground throughout but to no avail. STORM FLEUR reserved while outside foe, also raced mostly on two wide path and lacked needed response. SEARFAVORITSESECRET was forwardly placed from the outside, dropped back while three wide around the turn and weakened.
