**Footnotes**

LOVEITORLOOSEIT quickly sped to the front while crossing over, set uncontested pace from the inside then along the rail into the stretch, drifted out bit and desperately lasted under strong urging. INDIAN GAMING stalked from the inside, drifted out some exiting the turn, rallied under right hand urging, whittled gap on leader late and just missed while outside winner. GOODLOOKINDUDE chased from the inside, remained along the rail into and through the stretch,also made late gains on winner and gamely gained third. LONELY STREET came in early, tracked the leaders from the inside then three wide into the stretch, loomed from between horses in the drive but was outfinished for third. SHADY VOTES saved ground chasing the pace, continued on two wide path to the stretch and lacked needed response. MR ZIP IT was bit slow to begin and lagged back in the early going, came in some but never menaced. TROUBLE AT SEA broke out, chased from well off the rail, raced four wide on the turn, came in slightly and weakened.
