**Footnotes**

FORD ISLAND forced the early issue from the inside, drew even on the turn then gained advantage exiting the bend, quickly cleared and safely held from along the rail. MR. INN ZONE close up early from the inside, taken off the fence midway on the backstretch, advanced three wide, drifted out some leaving the turn, lugged out further in the drive but still gained the place. SEAFIRE angled over while chasing the pace, saved ground into the stretch then rallied along the fence then inside PREPPY PILOT late to gain the show. PREPPY PILOT stepped to the front, set pressured pace from outside eventual winner, lost command entering the stretch and weakened late in the drive. PIRATE'S JOURNEY settled off the pace and off the rail, chased three wide then outside foe into the lane and lacked needed response. WARRING HEART was void of early foot, trailed from bit off the fence, raced three wide into the lane and was outrun throughout.
