WILD WORLD broke sharp, asked a bit early to show the way, cleared in the turn, all out to last. BACK BAY BARON pressured the winner early from the inside, fell back off that one into the turn, moved out, roused for the drive, closed the gap on the winner late. IFTHESHOEFITS in the second flight toward the inside, angled out a bit for the drive, managed some close late. OFF DUTY last away, off the pace and the inside, crossed to the rail for the drive, some late interest to miss the show. ALLOWANCE fell back to trail early, found best stride too late on the far outside. FOUR SEVENS within striking distance for a half, lacked a late punch. CREAM LEVEL improved position, never really dangerous. DYNAMITE WILL remained back. ULTIMATE VICTORY forwardly placed early, staged a steady retreat. SHAWNSMOVINGON five wide in the turn, tired. POTOSI WELLS squeezed back turn.
