COMMERCIALIZE outrun early, made a good gain four wide through the second turn to reach the front, kicked clear in the drive under steady handling. HOMECOMING lacked early foot, came four wide into the stretch, up for the place. SMOKEY DIPLOMACY three wide when with the pace through the first turn, dueled up the backstretch, proved little match for the winner when confronted by that foe, caught late for the place. PROSPECTORS SPIRIT forwardly placed outside, waited behind horses into the straight, lacked a closing kick when clear. LEGISLADY in traffic in the second while well off the pace, improved position through the stretch while continuing in relative close quarters. KEOSNATIVE lacked room toward the inside late in the final bend, went evenly through the stretch. JUSTAKISS within striking distance, came up empty for the drive. ASHLEYS ART void of early foot in trailing, displayed some

belated interest while never dangerous. CLAUDIA'S AGENDA not a threat. I. B.'S HALO four wide in the first turn, raced forwardly, was tiring when put in tight turning for home, backed up. TINCAN TOO showed little in a dull effort. MAGGIO was finished after a half.
