A HANDICAP FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. \$200,000 added and an additional \$50,000 from the Breeders' Cup fund for cup nominees only. The host association's money to be divided 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 11% to third; 6% to fourth; 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Saturday, December 31, 2005, with 23 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 1 1/16 Miles).

SNOWDROPS (GB) took back off the pace early, remained in hand the middle half, surged to the fore with a strong move on the outside in the second turn, cleared and maintained daylight to the wire under steady handling. LA REASON unhurried, trailed into the straight, angled out a bit for room when asked for some run, finished willingly down the middle of the course to be clear for the place, no real threat to the winner. LENATAREESE lacked early foot, advanced within striking distance while four wide late in the final turn, flattened out a bit in the drive, managed to hold the show. BLACK ROCK ROAD forwardly placed, lodged a bid from between foes in the second turn, came up empty for the drive. WHERE'S BAILEY moved up early, took over after a half, dropped to the inside, narrowly showed the way out of the final turn, weakened in the final furlong. PAD THE WALLET set a soft pace while firmly in hand, had little left after five furlongs. VOZ DE COLEGIALA (CHI) raced briefly forward, finished early.
