FUTURE DIRECTION unhurried in the early going, advanced, strong move on the outside to challenge late in the final turn, steadily clear, kept to task. POINT MINISTER allowed to settle early, rallied three wide out of the final turn, no match winner, proved determined for the place. GETUPBILLYGETUP chased leader, moved to challenge second turn, no match for the winner in the drive, outfinished for the place. CHEROKEE LANDING lacked speed, improved position, no real threat. ANOTHER SLEW forwardly placed for a half, weakened. CATOFNINELIVES sprinted clear soon after the start, set the pace for six furlongs, gave way when headed turning for home. HIGH LOW GAME was finished early. S P WARRIOR trailed throughout.
