TALE OF A SAINT devoid of early foot, advanced five wide through the turn, continued full of run to the finish to win going away while remaining well out in the strip. RED SALT broke on top, vied three wide, came in a bit to tighten up inner rivals into the turn, well clear, continued to maintain a sizeable advantage until late, caught. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE INCIDENT INTO THE TURN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. NATES MINESHAFT off a step slow, raced far back for three furlongs, swung out to be widest in the drive, finished up willingly to earn the show. FOREST FLAG with the early pace while between foes, steadied slightly while in tight entering the turn, fell back, was going evenly at the end to be caught for the show. OH MIGHTY DOLLAR lacked speed, staged a mild rally to improve position, never really dangerous. HERSCHEL went evenly in lacking a closing kick. COVEY'S CASCADE shuffled back steadily along the inside late backstretch, steadied early in the turn in traffic, improved position through the stretch. A. P. TIME off slowly, trailed, passed tiring foes. UNEVEN SCORE with the pace along the inside, in tight, steadied into the turn, fell back, faded further the final furlong. ODIE ODIE O tired from early efforts. FLEE THE POSSE steadily faded. BLACK IDA'S JO JO behind the first flight for three furlongs, stopped in the drive.
