GIMMEALIFE forwardly placed, vied four wide out of the turn, drew out through the stretch. ISN'T SHE GORGEOUS forwardly placed, moved closer then challenged three wide then challenged inside the winner, no match for the winner late, clearly second best. CLASSIC KEY BRIDGE back early, altered course when lacking clear room when advancing midstretch, along for the show. DAWN'S TRIBUTE set or forced the pace for a half, weakened. ZAMANDA'S RULING five wide late in the turn, lacked a late bid. MISS JOHANNA with the pace for a half, gave way through the stretch. NANA KNOWS was never a factor. MY LADY BUDDHA slow early, continued to trail most of the way. INDIAN BRAID pressured the early pace outside, stopped.
