FAST CITY broke alertly, quickly got clear, rated through the turn, continued to maintain a daylight advantage into the lane, saw her lead diminish late while being kept to task. HEAVENS HALL raced back off the pace, saved some ground through the turn, advanced while continuing along the inside upper stretch, finished willingly to be closing the gap on the winner late. PATER FLATTER settled off the pace, also made some advance on the winner late, outkicked for the place. KEVIL KID closest to the winner, chased that rival into the stretch, remained closest to that rival until late, faltered. CAPE TOWN BRIDE off slowly, trailed, picked off a couple of tiring rivals after the issue had been decided. MIDGE FOUR settled off the pace, got out a bit to be wide out of the turn, staged a steady retreat down the lane. HOPESHESAMIRACLE was never a factor.
