Footnotes

SILKY SLEET four wide into the first turn when within contact of the early lead, continued to stalk up the backstretch while out in the course, challenged into the far turn, clear into the lane, not threatened the final furlong under steady handling. LANG HEART unhurried for a half, began to move closer late backstretch and into the turn, angled out five wide four room leaving the final turn, finished up willingly to annex the place. NACHOORDINARYGUY forwardly placed in the second flight toward the inside, restrained into the far turn, shuffled back slightly, evenly through the lane in lacking a closing kick. QUIET TITLE off the pace and the inside, moved a bit closer in the second turn, raced closest to the winner with a furlong remaining, flattened out. GLORIOUS STRIKE raced off the pace, lacked a significant response in the drive. ARCTIC COMET four wide much of the way, lacked a late kick. LAGNIAPPE IN B S L narrowly showed the way early, continued to vie the middle half mile, faded. KIOWA'S SECRET vied up front closest to the inside, also faltered when the real running began upper stretch. STORMINTOTHEFRONT remained back throughout in lacking a rally. METAIRIE within striking distance in the early going, steadily faded. WITCH'S VALLEY last away, trailed throughout in a dull effort.
