**Footnotes**

STORM BOOT LARRY tracked the early leaders toward the inside, asked along late in the turn, reached the front inside the furlong marker, proved best under continued steady handling. NORTH GOAL raced in midpack while outside, came four wide out of the turn, also was going well at the end to be clear for the place. CLASSIC LIL HOOVES dueled up front for a half off the inside, shook clear, could not last. MAURICEVILLE raced back off the pace, improved slightly while never a serious threat. MAY SING THE BLUES lacked speed, came five wide into the stretch, failed to muster a late kick. SILVER INDY tired from early efforts. JUMPONTHEBANDWAGON steadied at the start, failed to threaten. ALMOST LEGENDARY was never involved. TIMELY MINARDI set or forced the pace for a half closest to the inside and gave way.
