CAJUN CAVEMAN in the second flight outside, continued four wide through the turn, closer then challenged upper stretch, gained the advantage, turned back a late bid from the outside by the runner up in a determined effort. SURLEY outrun in the early going outside, five wide through the turn, rallied into the lane, challenged the winner late, denied. AD ON FIRST within striking distance off the inside and behind the first group, asked late turn, was making little inroads past the furlong marker when moved out a bit, along for the show while not a threat to the top pair late. ROYAL TAK void of early foot, roused three wide out of the turn, staged a late rally to improve. LINDAU vied up front while three wide through the turn, weakened in the drive. HANDS OFF vied up front while between rivals for a half and faltered. WITS END failed to make much of an impact. RED PRODUCTION with the pace while closes to the inside for four furlongs, gave way in the drive. HULA PIE five wide through the turn, failed to menace in the drive. BALIDOR DESOL was never a threat in racing always back. COPPERVALE was done early. PORTO POTTEA steadied at the start, outrun.
