COTEAU CAT allowed the pace to go early, advanced then knifed through and opening while three wide and under clever handling turning for home, drove well clear. TEENAGER IN LOVE pressured the leader from the outside while under restraint up the backstretch, moved on that rival and dueled through the second turn, offered little resistance to the winner in the drive, held sway for the place. FIEND A BIT off the pace, moved a bit closer while saving some ground through the second turn, slowly getting to the runner up. SALT DADDY chased the two leaders while off the inside, four wide out of the final turn, had nothing for the drive. BEE TREE lacked speed, made a middle move closer while four wide early in the final turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. YELLENA'S VISION last away, trailed early, little impact. CAESAR'S COIN broke on top, narrowly showed the way for six furlongs, stopped in the drive. WESTROCK GOLD was finished after a half.
