RUN MATTY dueled up front after an alert break, fell back a bit in the turn while off the inside, dropped to the rail nearing the furlong grounds, rebid late, up in time. BERNICE SPECIAL broke sharp, dueled, shook off the winner in the turn, larger lead upper stretch, faltered late to be caught in the final strides. VICTORIA MISS forwardly placed toward the inside, moved out midstretch, could do little with the top two late, clear of the rest. FAVRETTE lacked speed, improved position slightly while never dangerous. CATHERINE'S LADY settled off the pace, roused three wide late in the turn, lacked a significant late response. ILLUSTRIOUS DREAM four wide through the turn, also had little for the drive. CAJUN DANCING fell back to trail soon after the start, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while not a factor. CHEROKEES LAST BID off a bit slow, never a threat. GOOD THEATER four wide into the turn, gave way soon after, fell well back, eased under wire.
