### Footnotes

BURNING VALOR broke alertly, showed the way early, garnered a larger advantage in the turn, drew out stretch, slight bother by a loose horse deep stretch, clearly best. VERY POSSEBULL off the pace, rallied four wide out of the turn, proved no match for the winner stretch, steered out to avoid a loose horse, clearly second best. SLIGHTLY USED lacked speed, came on the outside into the lane when making a mild advance, steered out, cautiously handled due to a loose horse, finished best of rest. ZARBY'S DERBY DAY within striking distance, was beginning to tire when steered out and also cautiously handled in deep stretch. STRONG AND TOUGH forwardly placed early, was tiring when carefully handled deep stretch due to loose foe. CHA CHA RIOS veered in start to start a chain reaction of interference, in some traffic when back early in the turn, remained back, carefully handled late stretch as well. IMA SMASH OAK vied early, retreated, in hand late due to loose rival. GET IN DA HOUSE forced into the temporary rail after CHA CHA RIOS veered in, unseated rider. THE REVEREND JAMES shied when CHA CHA RIOS veered at the start, unseated rider as well. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE START AND THE LOOSE HORSE, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND.
