PERFECT TAP forwardly placed on the outside, moved to challenge while continuing out in the course turn, vied past the furlong maker then edged away under firm handling. PURRFECT GEM narrowly set the early pace, vied through the turn while continuing inside, could not match strides with the winner late, proved game for the place. FRESH behind the first flight off the inside, three path out of the turn, shifted to the far outside when straightened for home, finished willingly to be getting to the runner up. QUEST FOR SUCCESS set or forced the pace, vied between foes into the lane, did not have enough for the place. DOLLY BONZ lacked speed, roused for the drive, displayed some late interest while in traffic at the wire. AMOZAN RULER in the second flight just off the inside, lacked a winning kick. READY INTEREST raced inside, roused turning for home, in some traffic late. BABY REESE last away, trailed throughout.
