SALTY SID moved up closer along the inside into the turn, boxed in soon after, moved out, four wide leaving turn to lose ground to the winner, set down, in time. ALAINA'S AURORA broke on top, set the pace, shook clear when straightened for home, could not contain the winner. AFTERNOON HIGH pressed the runner up, could not match that one in the drive, saved the show. SUGAR IS SWEET broke in the air, recovered, prompted the pace three wide, had little left for the drive. WHATS UP MACK off slowly, was never dangerous. MARKET ICE hesitated at the start, railed for a half, displayed a modest amount of late interest. BANDIT'S BOOTY had nothing for the drive. ZARB'S WHIRL remained back in failing to threaten. ALL STAR CHRIS was outrun. SWEEPNOEVAL staged a steady retreat.
