MAE B TODAY hustled away from the gate, narrowly showed the way early, got clear before a half, larger lead far turn, not threatened in the drive while being kept to task. WAKE UP SAL allowed the pace to go early, improved position three wide late in the final turn, no match for the winner, fully extended to hold the place. WAJIR ON ME lacked speed, saved some ground through the second turn, got through along the inside entering the stretch, roused, getting to the runner up late. NO REGRET bumped hard both sides start, raced back and outside, improved position while not posing any kind of threat. BELO PURSE (BRZ) last away, trailed, passed tiring rivals. LOW PLACES settled off the pace, was four wide while improving slightly second turn, had nothing for the drive. NOLAN'S REVENGE broke out, bumped NO REGRET, straightened to vie between rivals early, chased the winner into the far turn, gave way. WHY SEVENTEEN broke in to also soundly bump NO REGRET, vied briefly into the first turn while three wide, backed up after six furlongs.
