LILA GRACE allowed the pace to go early while saving ground, advanced up the rail to challenge late backstretch, vied through the final turn, kicked clear in the drive while under steady handling. LA BEIGNET forwardly placed, pressured the two leaders while three wide in the second turn, proved no match for the winner in the drive, narrowly held the place. BUBBA PRINCESS settled off the pace, roused while four wide late in the final turn, also proved no match for the winner late, closed the gap on the runner up. DOCTOR BECKY raced toward the front while three wide in the first turn, fell back a bit before a half, lacked a kick in the drive. SNUCKOUT TWICE unseated rider, ran off post parade, unruly when remounted, handwalked to the gate, pressed, bid second turn, gave way in the drive. SAINT BRESY was never a threat. NOTELL NOTAIL also not a factor, well beaten.
