Footnotes

CONTEMPORARY ART allowed the pace to go early, lodged a quick move toward the inside late in the second turn, engaged the leaders three wide soon after, drew out to be clearly best. DAKOTA COMET settled off the pace, rallied three wide out of the final turn, finished willingly to be up late for the place, no threat to the winner. PROVOKE ME pressed early, carried out a bit exiting the first turn, vied up front while between rivals up the backstretch, larger lead briefly in the second turn, offered little resistance to the winner in the drive, nipped late for the place. ROYAL BIDDER rider did not carry whip, five wide through the first turn, continued well wide backstretch, extremely wide turning for home, went evenly in the drive. LITTLEMUDDYJACK lacked speed, was never seriously a threat in the drive. REMEMBER HOAGY showed the way early, got out onto the backstretch carrying out two rivals, continued to vie the middle half then weakened in the drive. SOMETHING'S FISHY last away, trailed most of the way in failing to menace. IGNITER forwardly placed, vied outside, carried out onto the backstretch, pressed, stopped.
