SAINTS VISION chased the early pace from the outside, dueled through the turn while three abreast, shook loose mid stretch and was well clear while never asked. YANKEE GRIND off a step slow, rushed up inside to duel for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, held a forward position for the drive but could not match strides. ALARMING PLEASURE well placed from the inside, advanced entering the turn, responded but could only gain the show. HORATIO JETTA forced the early pace from the outside, came five wide into the drive, made a bid but faltered late. GARNET SILK chased the early pace from the inside but had no late response. BANK THIEF dueled from the inside and tired. DONNA'S BLUE BAYOU showed little. PLANTATION MAN trailed throughout.
