**Footnotes**

EXCITING EMPRESS unhurried early after a bit of a slow beginning, rallied three wide into the lane, reached the leader past the furlong marker, won going away. MS ROYAL BELEK lacked speed, rallied four wide out of the final turn, proved no match for the winner while finishing willingly to be well clear for the place. WANDASLITTLEANGEL settled off the pace, saved ground in the second turn, moved out for the drive, went evenly in the final furlong. KISS HER TWICE off the pace, raced toward the inside second turn, asked for some run with a quarter remaining, checked in tight quarters along the rail midstretch, did not recover. AL'S NO TWO PENCIL trailed for five furlongs, found best stride too late while improving position. DINABABE'S JET cleared to the inside, long lead, fell apart in the final furlong. SASSYS TERMS closest to the leader, had nothing for the drive. GENTLE WAYS tired in the drive. STORMING LILLIE was finished after a half. MISTY COAST forwardly placed for four furlongs, stopped.
