**Footnotes**

LUCKY TRADITION broke on top, alternated up front off the inside, long drive, proved narrowly best in game fashion. GRESHAM narrowly set the early pace, dueled up front closest to the inside, outfinished. NORTH GOAL off the early pace and the inside, closer three wide second turn, continued within striking distance outside the top two past the furlong marker, no late gain. PRIETO JOLIE last away, trailed early, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while never dangerous. ITSALLBOUTTHECHASE settled off the pace, lacked a closing response. DUSTY TUNNEL closest to the top two for five furlongs and began to weaken.
