ANGELONMYSHOULDER (GB) within striking distance inside, moved out three wide and advanced on the leaders turning for home, took over, drove clear. LA PIANO MAN fell steadily back off the pace the opening quarter, roused late in the turn in the three path, switched to the far outside when straightened for home, finished up willingly. BUTTER BROWN steadied at the start, lacked speed in racing back and off the inside, swung out to be six wide into the lane, showed some late interest while remaining well out in the strip. KAT'S COURT void of speed, moved out to be widest in the drive, also displayed some late run while too late. CRAFTY CAL set or forced the pace off the inside for a half, narrowly showed the way into the lane, could not last. COMEON HAYNESVILLE dueled up front along the inside for four furlongs, faltered in the drive. ELI'S GOLD within striking distance off the rail, tired four wide. THE DIVINE TUNNEL in the second group while five wide late in the turn, backed up in the drive.
