RAZADDAX vied up front for three furlongs, fell back off the leader late in the turn, came again rail, well clear at the end. GATOR CHOMP narrowly set the pace from the outside, continued to vie turn, appeared to come in slightly causing JOHN ETBAUER to clip heels midway on the turn, showed the way into the lane while well off the inside, proved no match for the winner the final furlong. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE INCIDENT IN THE TURN, GATOR CHOMP WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM SECOND AND PLACED NINTH. POWDERHORN HEAT close up early inside, fell back off the leaders, moved out, bumped by loose horse and off strided late in the turn, recovered and finished up clear of the rest. SHERIFF WARREN off the early pace and the inside, took up to avoid a stricken foe midway on the turn, steered out a bit, set down in upper stretch and finished up evenly. OUR DIVA FACTOR off the pace and the inside early, dropped toward the rail turn, avoided trouble midway on the bend, also went evenly in the drive in lacking a serious late bid. BOSTON MAGIC off slow, trailed, also saved ground through the turn, improved position inside of troubled foes, not a serious threat. TIZ OUR INSIGHT well back off the inside, swerved suddenly to avoid trouble in the turn to lose all chance. HIGH MAGIC was racing in midpack when forced to take up midway on the turn to avoid trouble, did not recover. SUNDOWNROCKET was racing well back when taken up in the turn, continued far back. JOHN ETBAUER vied up front while between foes, in tight, clipped heels midway on the turn, unseated rider.
