NANA KNOWS forwardly placed along the inside, moved up to challenge inside the leader into the far turn, drew steadily clear while being kept to task. SWEET EUGEENA set the pace while off the inside, allowed the winner the inside into the second turn, could not match strides with that foe in the drive, well clear of the rest. ILLUSION OF SPEED chased the pace throughout, no gain stretch, best rest. IDE DOUBLE UP void of early foot, staged a mild, belated rally while making little impact. CLASSIC KEY BRIDGE in the second flight early while toward the inside, was never dangerous. CLASSIC MOCCASIN well back in the early going, lodged a mild middle move up the rail backstretch, hung in the drive. CLEVER THIRTEEN showed little in a dull effort. QUE HORA ES began to fade after a half.
