PRETTY NEAT broke on top, got clear and toward the inside soon after, expanded advantage into the stretch, kept to task late. GALPAL in the second flight from the start, continued to chase into the lane, could do little with the winner, clearly second best.. WHY GO WEST lacked early foot, raced in traffic while still back late turn, continued to be surrounded by foes upper stretch while improving, finished up best of the rest. SET PLANS four wide into and through the turn when off the pace, went evenly through the stretch. SELARI'S HONOR lacked early foot, came five wide into the stretch, managed little in the way of a rally. SUGARTOWN LADY lacked speed, raced in tight while in traffic late turn, fell back to trail, passed tiring foes. HAILI HOPE made little in the way of an impact. LEE'S ANGEL weakened in the drive. CARONELLA chased the winner for three furlongs and stopped.
