Footnotes

BELUSKO'S BABE unhurried for six furlongs, began to advance five wide turning for home, wore down leaders. LACE CASTELLI lacked early foot, traffic, waited briefly entering the stretch, split foes, mild bid, second best. SEA MERGE also outrun early, remained well back into the stretch, lacked room, steadied behind a wall of horses midstretch, mild gain. GO FOR MATTY forwardly placed and four wide when challenging second turn, lacked a late kick. KATLIN'S ROCKET prompted the pace off the inside, weakened through the stretch. ONCE A PROMISE forward early, began to fade before a half. CATERETTE duelled backstretch off the rail, gave way. SILVERWILLDO set a quick opening quarter along the inside, stopped in the drive.
