Footnotes

LOST IN SIBERIA close from the start, dueled into and through the turn off the inside, shook off the other speed when straightened for home, enough left to hold two challengers safe late. SHEZACOMMANDER slow early, continued to trail into the turn, slipped through along the rail when rallying stretch, angled out a bit late, willingly late between foes. AUTUMN LEE lacked speed, rallied on the outside and finished willingly to also be getting to the winner. SOLDER'S STARLET evenly paced off the rail, closest to the winner upper stretch, lacked a late punch. ELLE MORENO showed the way early, dueled through the turn, faltered in the drive. PACIFICVALI was not a serious threat. APPALACHEE GOLD had little left outside. ANNIE ROONEY failed to menace. TENSAS FORTY steadily faded, well back.
